

Fuchu is the host town for Austria and Australia



What's a host town?

Using the opportunity of the Tokyo 2020 Games, local governments looks to have mutual exchanges on a human, economic and cultural scale through inviting pre-games camps and register with the national government as a host town. It is expected that a nation-wide spread of host town helps promote the Games all over the country.

Why Austria and Australia?

Fuchu entered into a friendship city alliance with Hernals in Vienna in 1992. We have continued youth exchanges and other activities since then. This long-standing relationship has developed deep ties and led to Fuchu

registering as a host town in December 2017. So far, host town business has included offering an Austrian school lunch. We are scheduled to have exchanges that deepen mutual ties including inviting Austria's national table

Also, in January 2018, Fuchu City signed a memorandum of understanding to hold pre-Games camps with Baseball Australia in connection with the Olympic Games Tokyo 2020, and in February, we are registered as a host town for Australia. Up until now, Australia's national baseball and wheelchair basketball teams held pre-games camps in Fuchu, and also youth exchange activity of baseball with Robina High School was carried out.



A large, beautiful country that lives in harmony with nature.





Nere-Games Camps Fucho

Fuchu City is located near Tokyo Stadium, where the Tokyo 2020 Games will be held. We have hosted pre-games camps from various countries.

What's a Pre-Game Camp?

A pre-game camp is a training camp to help Olympic and Paralympic Committee members and sports organizations from various countries adapt to the time change, climate before the Games.

Athletes will be able to train in a comfortable environment, so that they can provide their best performance at the time of their events. Hosts of the camps expect regional promotion and the advancement of international relations.


